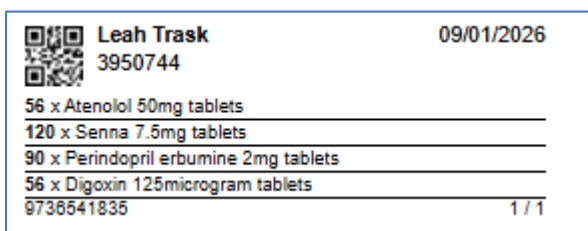

Picklist Labels

We have introduced Picklist Labels into RxWeb. This we hope will act as an alternative to printing tokens based on user feedback that tokens are commonly printed to support picking drugs.

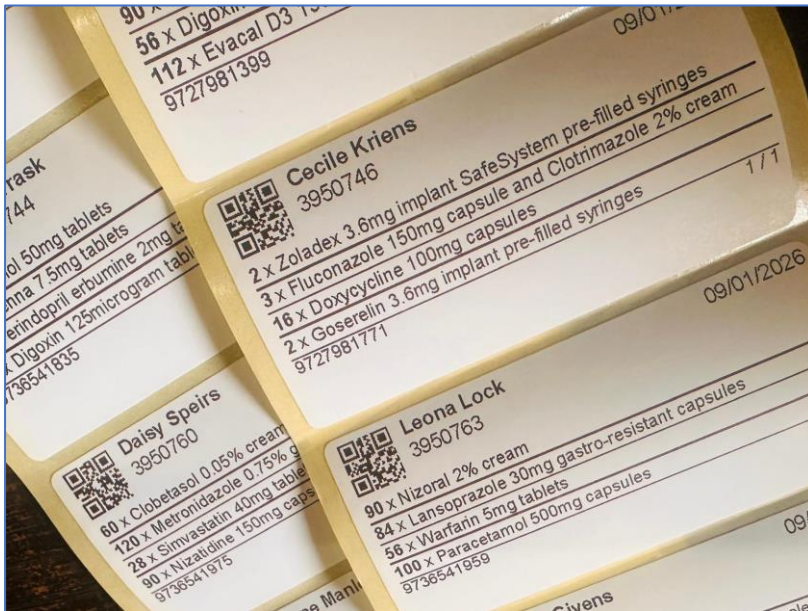
The Picklist Labels are 1 label per Script and contain a list of what has been prescribed with the quantity. They also contain a QR Code which is the RxWeb Script ID. This ID is the same ID that appears on the Bag Labels and can be used system wide to perform many existing functions.

- Accuracy Checker
- Scan to Claim
- BagTraker

Here you can print multiple picklist labels like you can print multiple tokens.







Scan2Claim – Script ID

Scan2Claim will now accept the scan of RxWeb Script ID's (Bag Label ID), previously this only worked with EPS barcodes. Once you press CLAIM the rows in the grid will show the EPS barcode that relates to the internal ID.

OPD - Changes to RxWeb to better support Original pack Dispensing

We have added a new module in Group Admin under the Stock menu for OPD (Original pack Dispensing) which allows you to specify Packs that the system is to treat as OPD if it qualifies.

e.g. If you were to add **Fluoxetine 10mg capsules 30 Pack** into your OPD List. When you dispense a prescription that is prescribed as 28, the system will automatically adjust the dispensed quantity to the 30 pack, as you have flagged that you want to do original pack dispensing on this item, and you're allowed to dispense 30 as it is within the 10% rule.

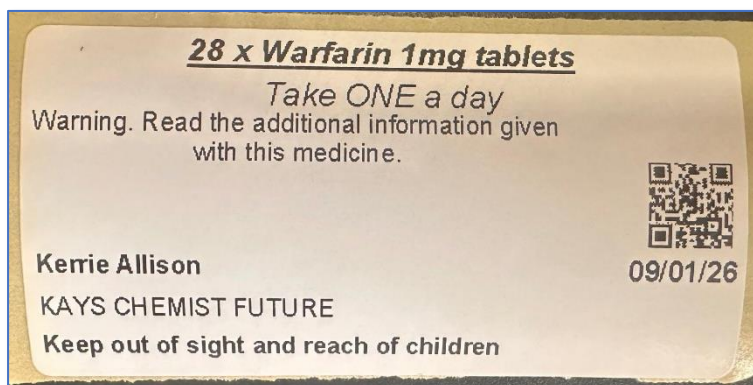

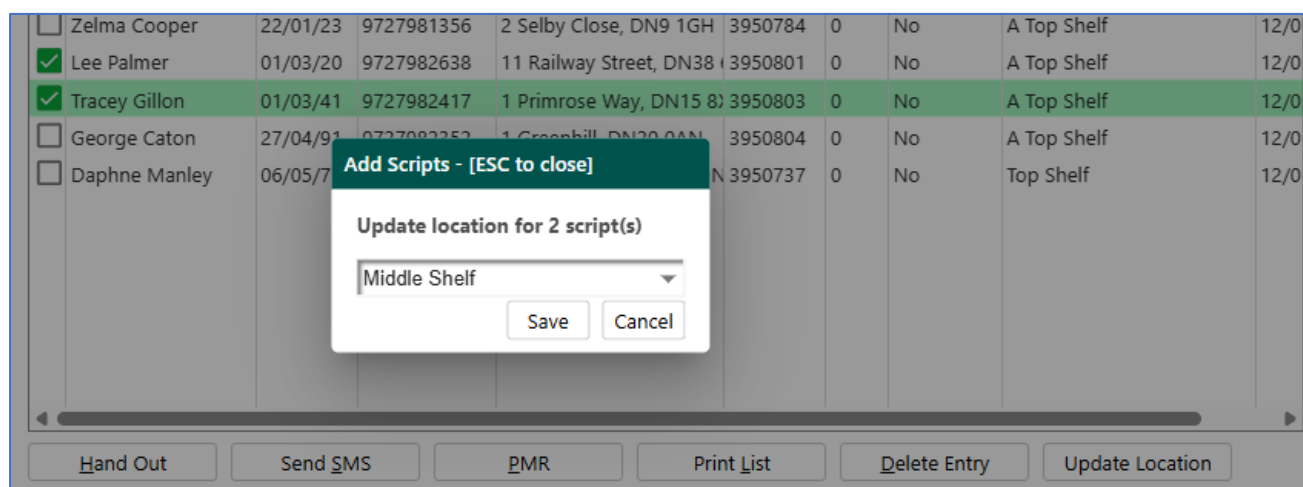

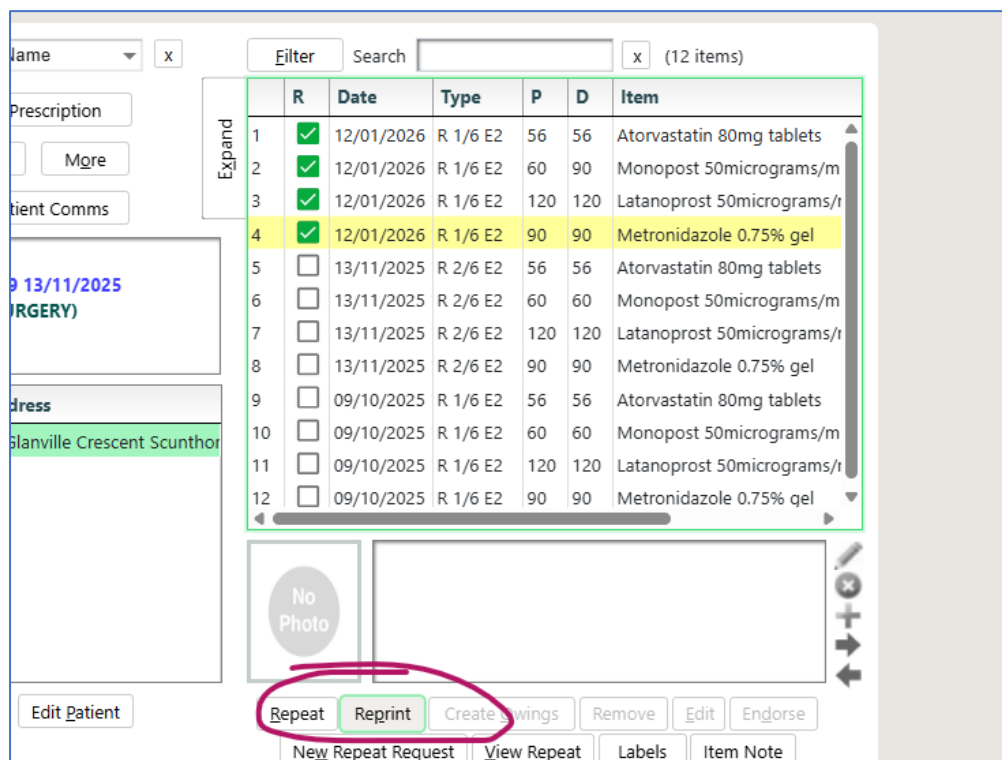
Switch Location in Bag Manager in RxWeb
